

5. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT Govt. from time to time.

26. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, addresspostal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.

27. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board
